



Location Guide SKSG Preschool

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This location guide is a location-based supplement to our General Information for parents.

International families are welcome with their babies and young children at SKSG.
We provide high quality day care with fully qualified English and Dutch speaking staff.

In collaboration with the international division of the GSV (Groningen School Association), SKSG offers a special double -language preschool program for 3 year old children. This program supports your child in acquiring the required skills for primary school and provides ideal preparation. The activities program of the preschool is based on international programs for early childhood education and is regularly adapted to reflect the latest developments. Our large garden at the preschool provides a fun playing area for the children. The preschool is managed by teachers from GSV and SKSG, and represents an ideal mix of education and day care.

Days and opening times Preschool

There are fixed preschool times on Monday morning, Tuesday morning, Thursday morning and/or Friday morning from 8:00 am to 1:00 pm. The minimum you can book is two mornings per week. As recommended by the Ministry of Education, Culture and Science (OCW), no childcare will be provided during the school holidays and SKSG's childcare centres are closed on public holidays for the region Noord. In principle, preschool ends when children turn 4. If your child is not starting primary school immediately, then you can extend the childcare by a maximum of three months. You can submit a written request for such an extension to the SKSG client service desk.

Registration and cancellation

Childcare with preschool can be requested through SKSG client service desk via telephone number 050-3171390 or online on the SKSG website. For cancelling the childcare before the agreed end date, please send a written cancellation to the customer service. A notice period of one month is applicable for reducing or cancelling the childcare.

The Location

The Preschool is located in the building at the Rijksweg 24 together with GSV.

The BSO Kids international is also located here. During the day, when the BSO does not use the classrooms, the Preschool uses the group.

The groups

The Preschool consists of 1 group and uses the group at SKSG Kids International. A maximum of 15 children are accommodated in the age of 3-4 years.

We then work with 2 staff members. (1 to maximum 8 children)

In addition to the tribe group, we use the gymnasium of the GSV which is situated in the same building for physical activities. We do this once or twice a week on Mondays and/or Thursdays.

Our Day

8:00 – 8:25	Drop Off
8:30 – 9:20	Registration/carpet time/Literacy lesson
9:20	Shoes and Jackets
9:30	Outside Play
9:55	Come inside
10:00	Snack
10:20 – 12:00	Learning Time (This includes Literacy/Phonics, Math, Themes, Music, Dance (and Science later in the year)
12:00 – 12:30	Lunch time
12:30 – 13:00	Pick-up time and Book time

When you get to Preschool in the morning, please help your child hang up his/her jacket, take off his/her outdoor shoes, and place his/her shoes under his/her jacket. Please help your child put on his/her indoor shoes. If you can, please put your child's name on things.

When your child comes in he/she can choose to play in different areas and do various activities. We do this from 8:00 to 8:25 as the children arrive and settle in. At 8:30 we start to clean-up and start our day.

Outside of the classroom the children have a drawer; this is where their extra clothes are to be kept. Please make sure there is a full set of clothes as often they are wet or sandy from outside and they need to change everything. When you take home a set of dirty clothes, please replace it with another set the next day.

At the end of the day, during pick-up time, please check your child's drawer to see if there are wet clothes, birthday treats and so on. At the end of the day also please put your child's inside shoes in his/her drawer. We are a shared classroom so the shoes can easily get lost if they aren't put away. On rainy days please send boots for your child or keep a pair in his/her drawer. We usually go out even if the ground is wet.

In the colder months please make sure you dress your child for a play outside. We usually go outside every day and only stay in if it's raining. The classroom is a shared space. We share it with the SKSG after-school program (BSO). There are limitations in the room (on what can be hung up, decorations, furniture, etc.). We always have to leave it clean for the next group so this is why you always see us tidying up at the end of the day.

For outdoor play activities we use the small square of the GSV. This is completely closed for safety by means of a fence. Children can play outside safely here.

Trusted Professionals

At the Preschool we work with two permanent staff members. Marieke from SKSG and Leah from the GSV. They are familiar to the children. If one of them is not available, we have fixed replacement available any time. If she is not available as well, we can call the Flexpool from SKSG.

The 4 eyes principle

SKSG ensures the best possible safety at our childcare centres.

The 4 eyes and ears principle means that 'the holder of a children's centre organizes the day care in such a way that the professional or professional in training can only perform the work while he can be seen or heard by another adult'.

SKSG-wide measures have been taken for this. In addition, each location has taken its own measures. The preschool staff never work alone on the group. There are always at least 2 people present. Even if there are less than 8 children.

Treat policy

The birthdays of the children are about the experience of the birthday. The child is central to this day. Here we really like to make a party together!
If you want your child to take a treat, please think about our dietary policy and take a healthy treat with you.
